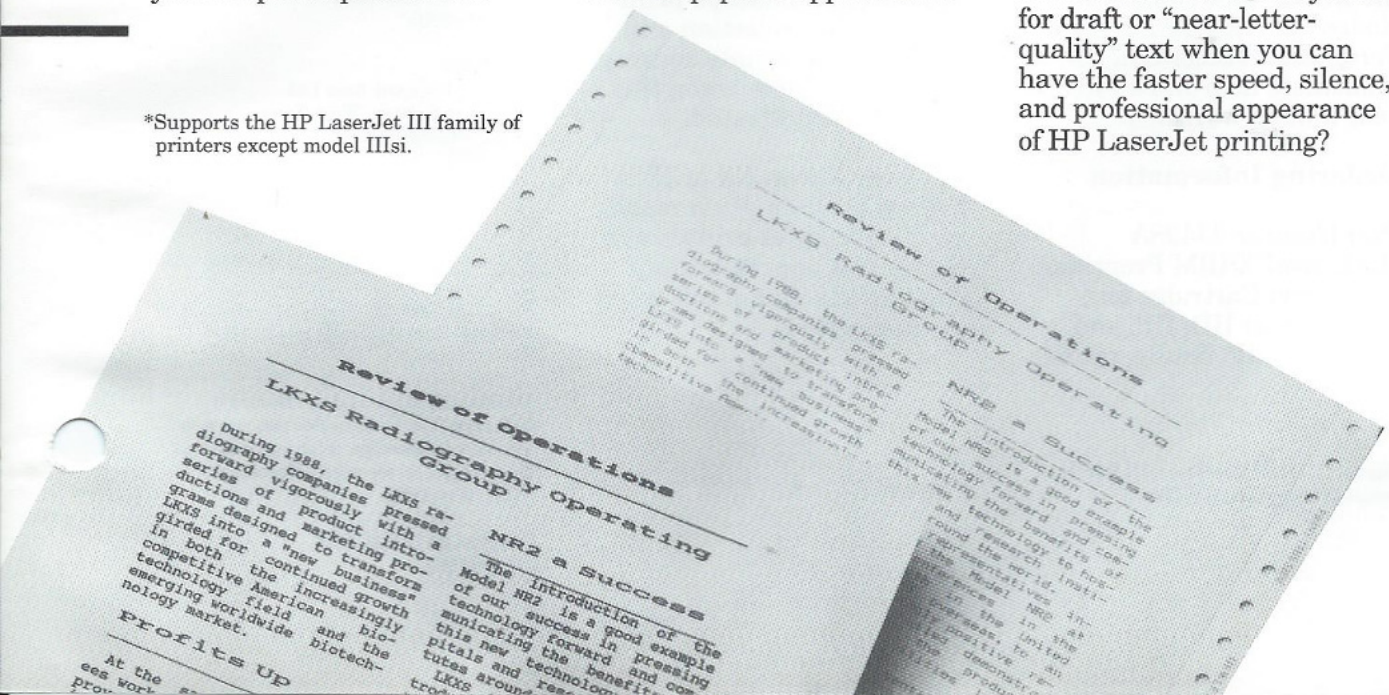

The cartridge also supports a hex mode which prints the hexadecimal representation of any data sent to the printer.

Limitations: Hewlett-Packard LaserJet printer's implementation of RS-232 handshaking may vary from your current Epson FX or IBM Proprinter configuration. To use this product, you may have to modify your current system configuration to continuously retry sending output to the printer if timeout errors occur.

Also, certain HP LaserJet printer features such as duplexing, landscape printing, dual bin selection and fonts from alternate sources are not available when this cartridge is activated.

In either Epson FX or IBM Proprinter emulation modes an HP LaserJet printer will perform at approximately one-half its maximum-rated print speed.
