To optimize the pace of your adventure we recommend that you load the demo to your system disk. Minimum system requirements: HP 9000workstation with audio capability, HP-UX 9.01 or later, 16MB RAM, 19" color monitor.

### The First Few Steps - How to Load

Insert the CD in the drive and, as root, mount the drive using SAM or the UNIX<sup>®</sup> mount command.

If you choose not to load on your hard drive, please be aware that the demo will not perform at its best. To play from CD enter the following command: /cdrom/PowerON-III. Replace "/cdrom" with the mount point you used in mounting your CD.

To load the demonstration to disk, use the bdf command to find a disk with sufficient available space. The demo requires approximately 400MB. Then enter the command:

/cdrom/copy\_to\_disk, where /cdrom is the mount point for the CD. You will be prompted to enter the destination directory on your system disk. You can now run the demonstration by double clicking on the PowerON executable icon in the directory you specified or by entering the command: /my\_directory/PowerON-III, where /my\_directory is the path name you supplied when copying from CD. The PowerON! demo requires certain multimedia capabilities. On start-up, PowerON! will check to see if they are available and, if not, will prompt you to install the software. The appropriate files are provided on the CD. Please be aware that this may replace existing audio or video files. You may want to save any existing files specified in the install script before executing. Execution of the install script must be done as root.

Whether playing from CD-ROM or hard disk, on the first playing you will have the option to create a log file on disk in which to store information you come across in your explorations. The file will be created in your home directory as ~/PowerON-III.log, or if no HOME environment variable exists, as /tmp/PowerON-III.log

If you have problems or are unfamiliar with the operation of any of these commands, contact your system administrator or refer to your system documentation.

### How to Navigate

First of all, listen up to your bush guide. He knows the way but he's not there to hold your hand either so here's a few hints to carry in your travel kit.

In each landscape, your cursor will point out the hot spots to visit. Double click on the landmark to explore further. Toggle switches will appear to allow exploration of specific topics, and if there are too many topics to tackle in a single glance the slider bar will give you access to the rest.

### **Performance Concerns**

The speed of a hard disk is much faster than a CD drive. Hewlett-Packard recommends putting this demo on hard disk for optimal performance. To copy the demo to hard disk please refer to instructions in the "How to Load" Section of this guide.

### Not Enough Colors

This demonstration requires a large number of free color map entries. On initialization, PowerON! will display a warning message if not enough color map entries are available. If you get this message, stop other programs that may be using a large number of colors and restart the demo.

### No Audio

If you are using a workstation or X station which supports audio, the audio server must be available and running. Contact your system administrator if you need help starting the server.

To play through headphones set the SPEAKER environment variable to external.

#### **Battle Zone**

If HP VUE is set with "Raise Window with Focus" as the operating mode, the user cannot control the Battle Zone game. The game window appears and constrains the cursor to its window. The PowerON! main window grabs keyboard focus and rises to the top, which obscures the Battle Zone window. To work around this, deselect the "Raise Window with Focus" menu item from the Style Manager-Window menu. Don't forget that while you're on your adventure those of us back home would appreciate a line now and again. Send us tales of your travels!
