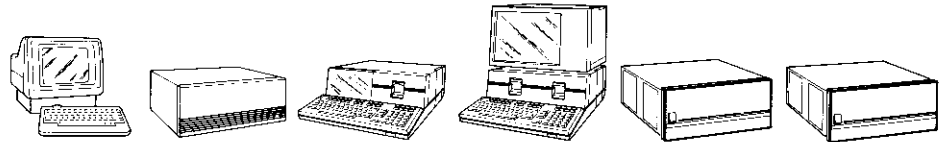


HP 9000 Family Products

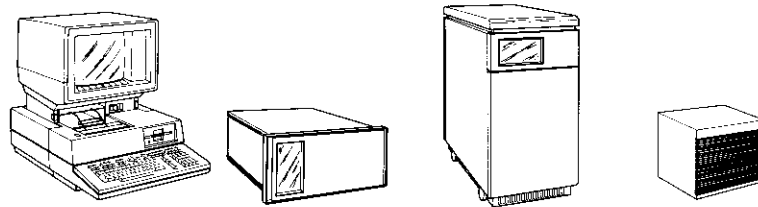
There have been some recent changes in our product numbering scheme for the HP 9000 Family of computers. The illustration below shows all of the numbers that are associated with each computer. Find the diagram of your computer and familiarize yourself with its various numbers.

HP Series 200 Computers

- The **product number** is the number you used to order your computer.
- The **Model Number** is a combination of the series number and product number. It tells you which model of computer you have in the HP 9000 Family. For example, the Model 216 refers to the Series 200 computer having the product number 9816.
- The **Previous Model Number** is the model number the computer had before the current, three-digit model numbering scheme was adopted. Recent models have no previous model number.

Any of these numbers can appear in the documentation. Just remember that they all refer to the same computer.
