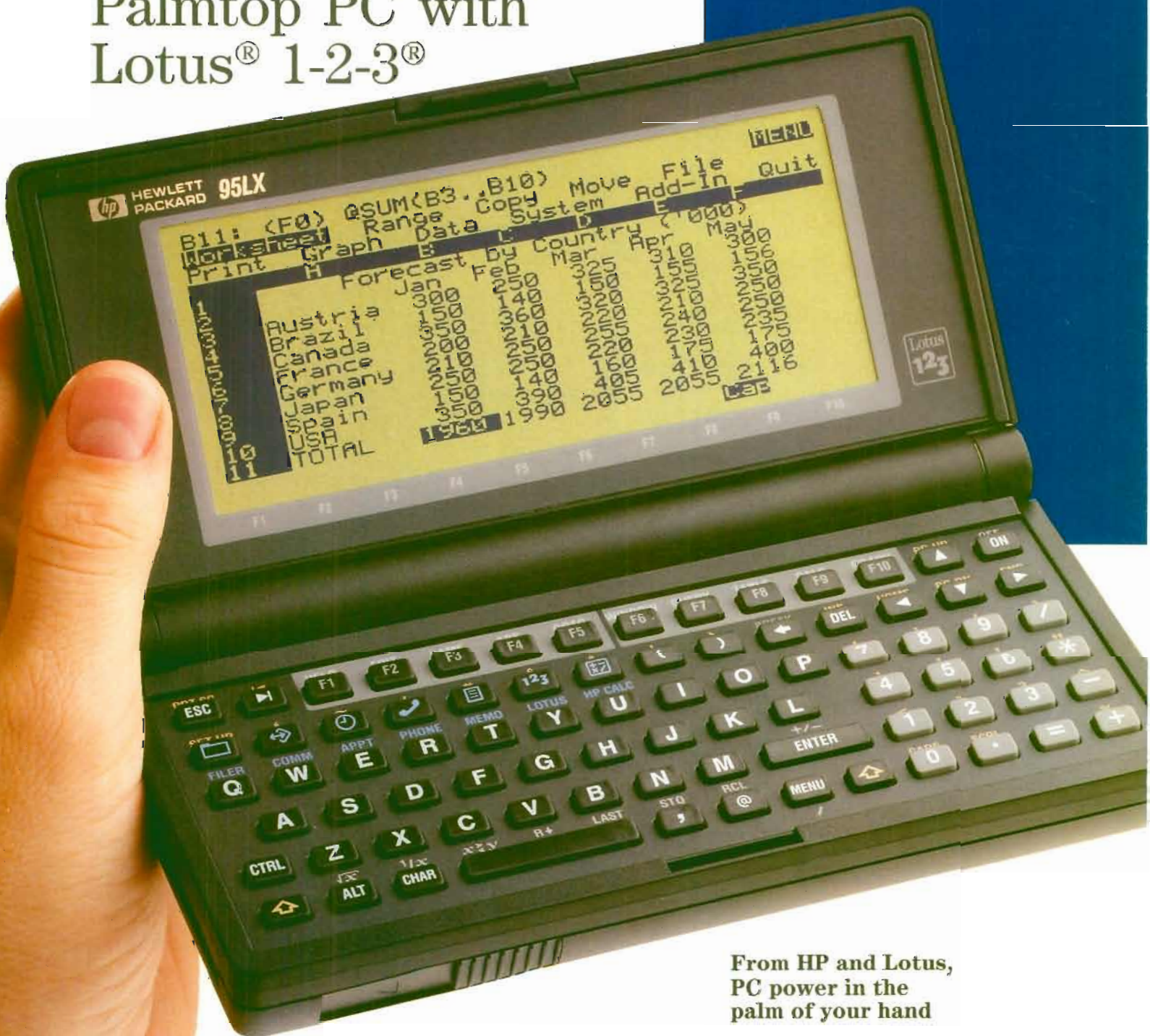

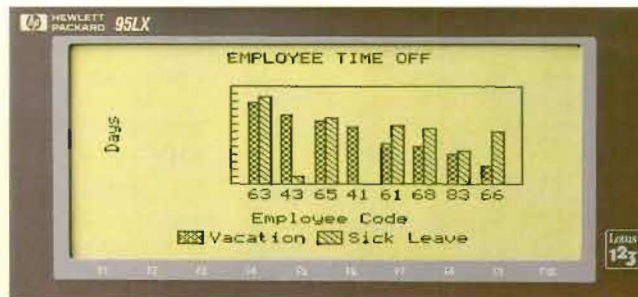
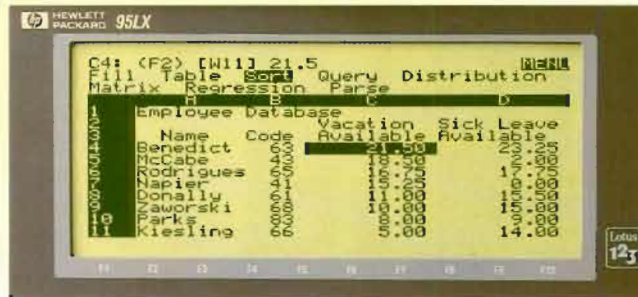

Lotus 1-2-3 features at your fingertips


Lotus 1-2-3 Release 2.2 is built into the HP 95LX. Including *database commands, graphics, and macro capability*. You can use *@ functions and link files*.


With the optional HP F1001A Connectivity Pack, you can transfer files back and forth between your IBM-compatible PC and your HP 95LX. This means you can create large worksheets using the full-size keyboard and larger display of the desktop PC and carry those same worksheets in the 11-ounce HP 95LX.



Plus HP 95LX extras

Run Lotus 1-2-3, or any of six other built-in HP 95LX applications, by pressing an application key. We call it *one-key access*; you'll call it great! One-key access also lets you move among the built-in applications without losing your place.

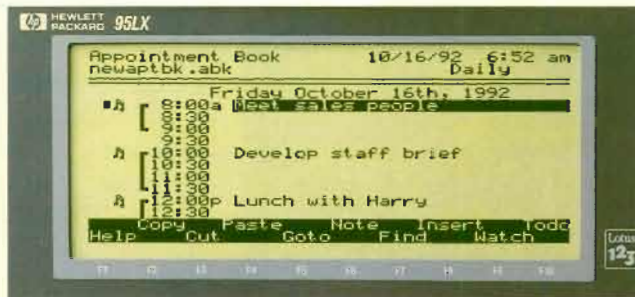
For example, you're updating a Lotus 1-2-3 worksheet and need to check a phone number. Simply press , the phone book key, and find the number.

When you're done, press  to get back into Lotus 1-2-3, exactly where you left off.

You can also copy a piece of a worksheet and move it to another application. The information is carried on the HP 95LX *clipboard*.

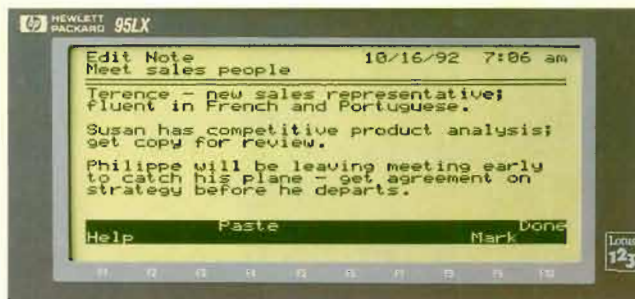
And, 1-2-3 graphics are enhanced with a *zoom* feature that gives you a close-up view of a portion of a chart.

A look at appointment book



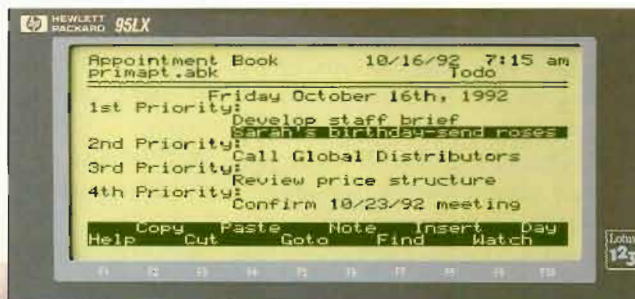
Time management

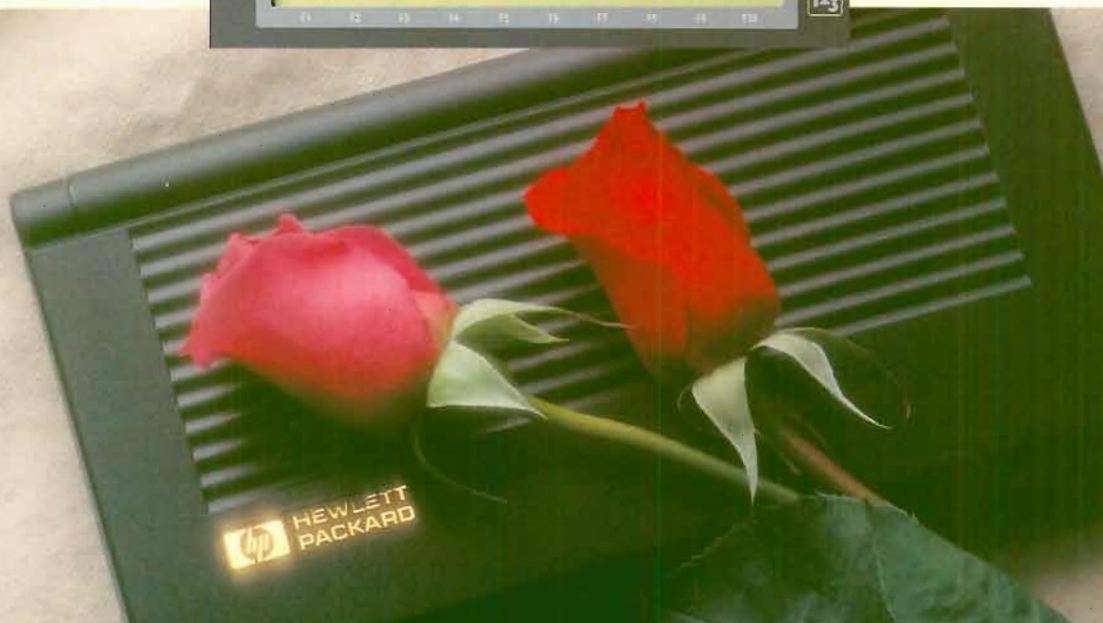


Notes and lists to keep you organized

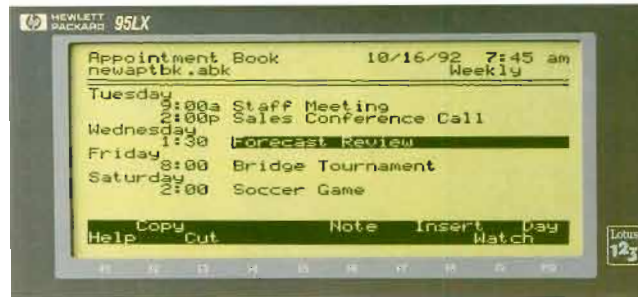

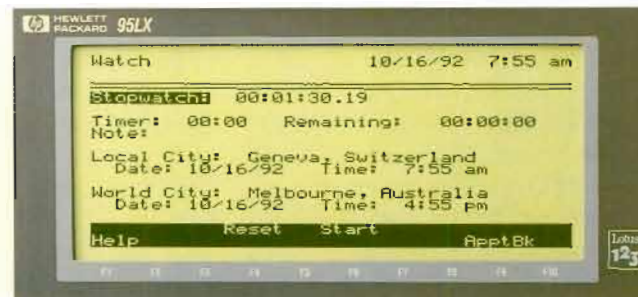

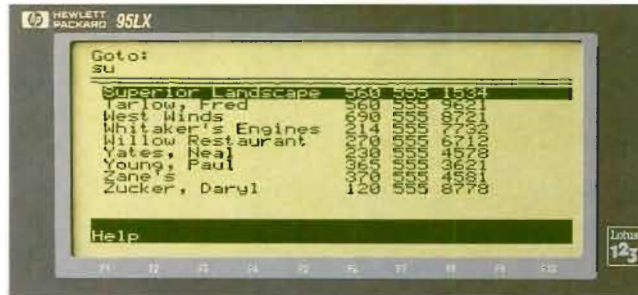
What time is it in Dallas? In Geneva? In Melbourne? Access the *city list*, highlight a city, and read the *time* at the top of the screen.



Need to time a phone call, work process, or speech? You can even use the HP 95LX as a *stopwatch*.

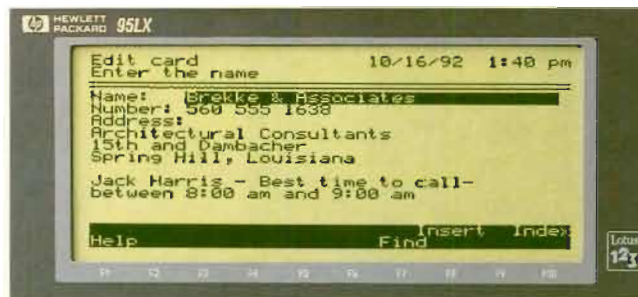

Names and numbers

Carry your business and personal *phone lists* with you. Instantly find a number by searching on the first letter or two of a name.



A place for other vital statistics, too

Augment your HP 95LX phone book with information *cards* on specific contacts. You'd like to discuss new technology with that fellow you met at the annual convention. You can't remember his name but you do remember his company is in Spring Hill.

In the phone book's index listing, press **F7** (Find). Type in Spring Hill and press **ENTER** twice. There's the card you completed on Jack Harris and it reminds you the best time to reach him is between 8:00 am and 9:00 am.

Clipboard lets you copy a name and phone listing, or card information, and move it to another application.



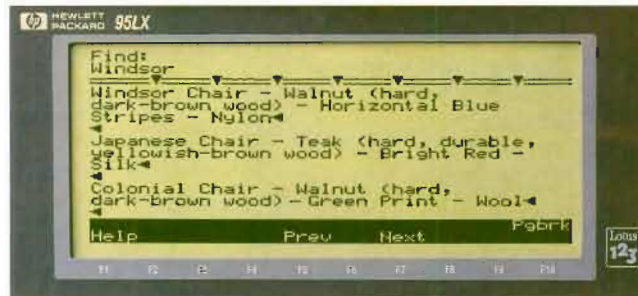

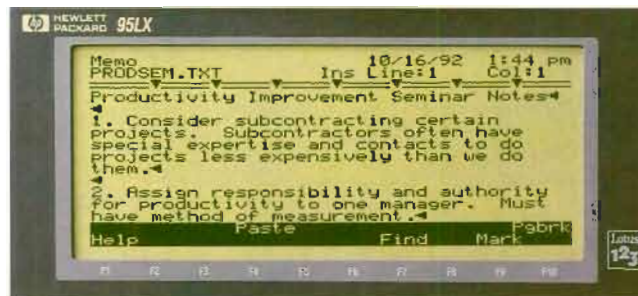
Versatile editor, reference tool, and note-taker

You've drafted this month's report on your desktop PC and transferred it to the HP 95LX. But, a section is incomplete. Visit your

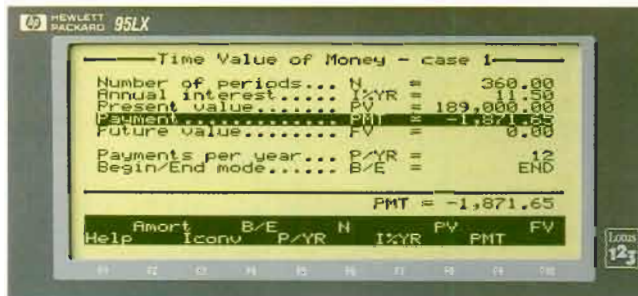

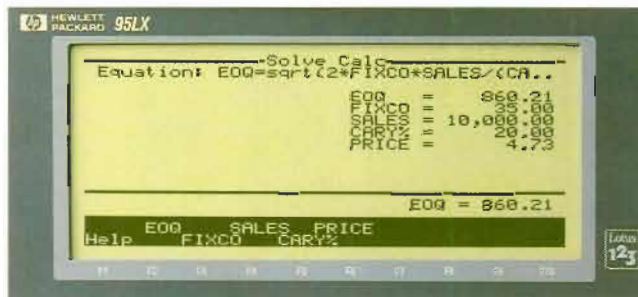

Creating a custom calculator

If you use specific equations frequently, enter them into the calculator using the *HP Solve* application. It turns your HP 95LX into a customized problem solver.

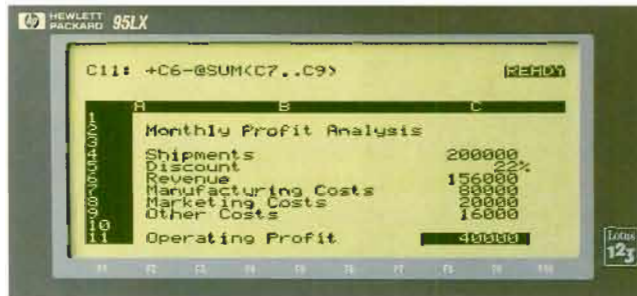




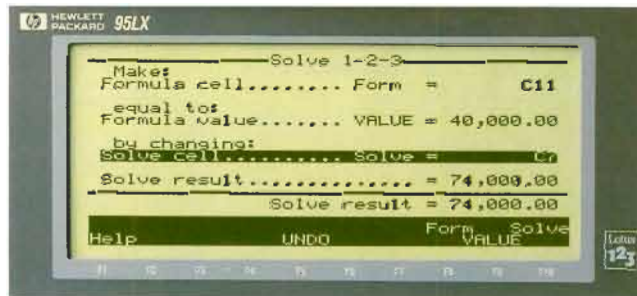
Backsolving to reach a known goal

Extend the what-if capability of Lotus 1-2-3 using its link to the HP 95LX calculator. The calculator's *Solve 1-2-3* feature

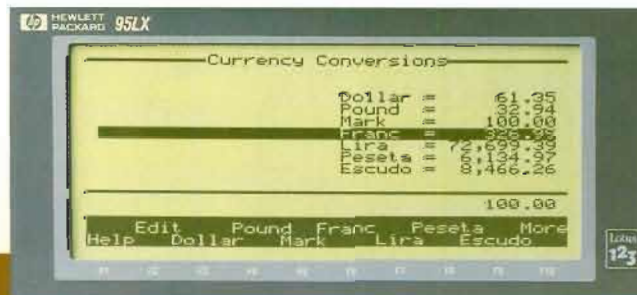
computes the value of one cell in a worksheet to achieve a desired result in another cell.



For example, you're working with cell C11 which holds the formula for determining monthly operating profit. To maintain shipments next month, you must raise discount from 22% to 25%. If other costs remain constant, by what amount would manufacturing costs have to decrease to preserve profit?



Access *Solve 1-2-3*, input the formula cell and its value, and solve for manufacturing costs which are in cell C7. The calculator *backsolves* to the answer.



Plus HP 95LX extras

Want to convert marks into francs? Miles into kilometers? Ounces into grams? Just select the conversion list you need for *currency, length, area, volume, or mass*.

Calculate *markup, margin, and other percentage changes* using built-in business functions. Using *clipboard*, move the result of any calculation to another application.

You can even calculate an *amortization schedule* and send it as a table directly into a Lotus 1-2-3 worksheet.

PC-to-palmtop file transfer



The easiest way to exchange files between an IBM-compatible PC and the HP 95LX is with the optional HP F1001A *Connectivity Pack*.^{*} This pack includes a serial cable and datacomm software for the PC. Plus PC versions of appointment book, phone book, memo editor, calculator, and filer. So, you can create schedules, phone lists, and memos, use them on your desktop PC, and transfer copies of them to the HP 95LX.

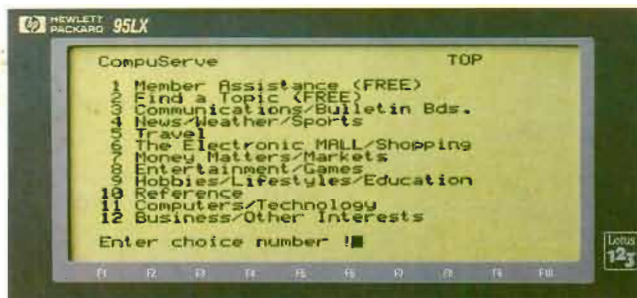
For exceptional convenience, the Connectivity Pack also includes Traveling Software, Inc.'s *DOS-Connect*[™], a utility that lets your desktop PC treat the HP 95LX as a disk drive. Within a software application on the PC, you can retrieve a file from, or save a file to, the HP 95LX.

Additional file transfer capability

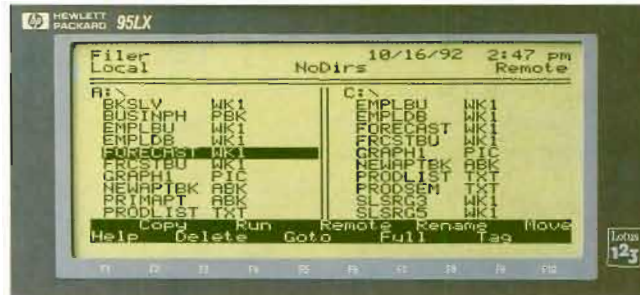
Use *standard datacomm protocols* that are built into the HP 95LX as an alternative way to transfer files to and from a remote computer.[#]

Dial-up information

The HP 95LX built-in datacomm application lets you access *information services* such as Dow Jones News/Retrieval and CompuServe[™].^{*} And, you can save data you receive into a *capture file* to carry with you in the HP 95LX.

The HP 95LX filer application includes a *split-screen* feature that facilitates PC-to-palmtop file transfer. You see the name of the file appear after the file is copied from one to the other.

And, two HP 95LXs can conveniently swap files. Transfer data via the built-in *infrared interface* — no cable connection is necessary.

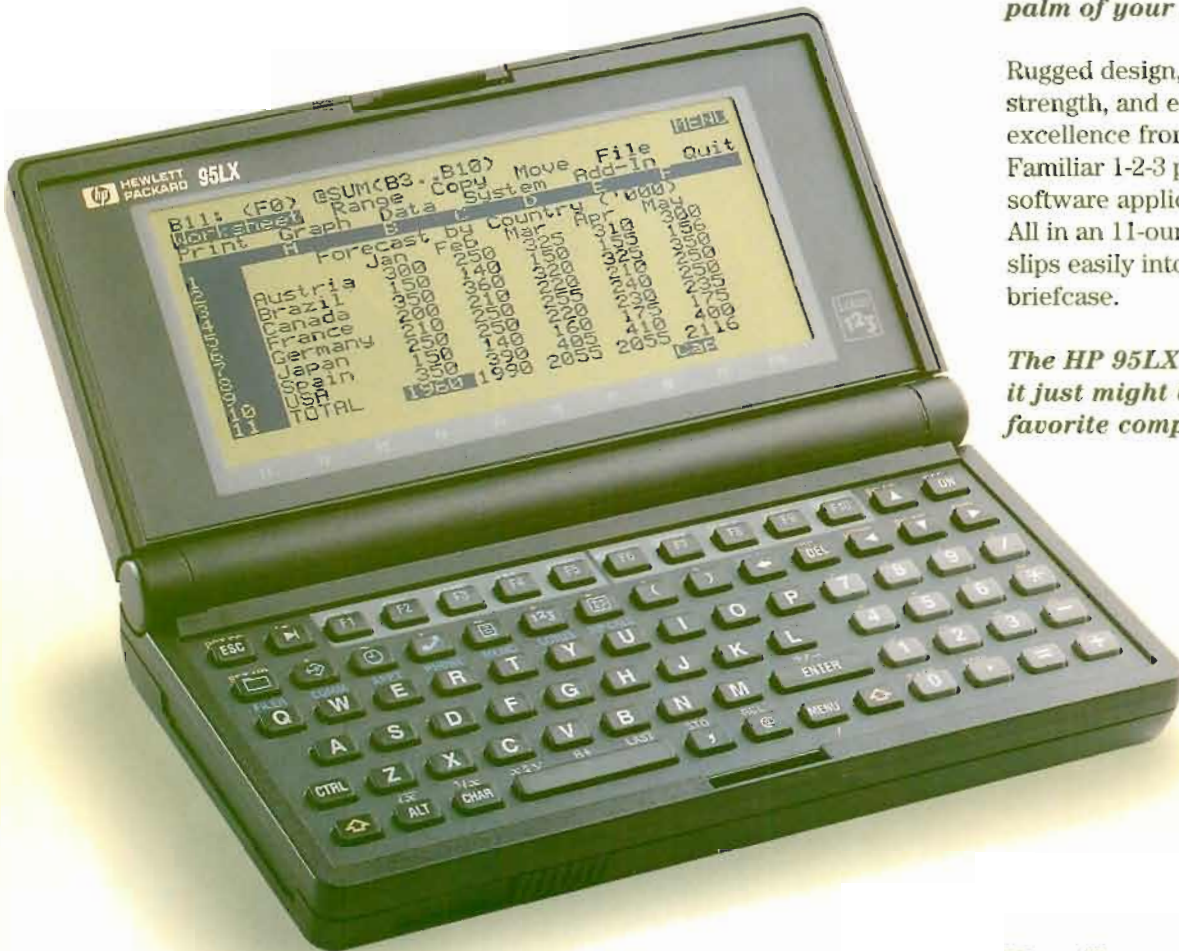

Appointment book features let you:

Phone Book

Phone book features let you:

- View the elements and progress of each calculation on the large HP 95LX display; see labeled variables, the contents of 10 storage registers, or the history stack
- Use the HP Solve application to customize the calculator with often-used equations—solve for one variable in terms of the others without rewriting the equation
- Store HP Solve equations to the Solve Catalog
- Use Solve 1-2-3 to backsolve to a desired result in a Lotus 1-2-3 worksheet—calculate the value of one cell to achieve a desired value for another cell
- Plot an equation or mathematical expression, zoom in on chosen areas of the graph, and calculate roots
- Use technical math functions including:
 - Trigonometric functions
 - Polar/rectangular coordinate conversions
 - Exponential and logarithmic functions
 - Integer part, fractional part, and absolute value
 - Rounding a number
 - Random number generation

Data Communications

The datacomm application in the HP 95LX lets you:

- Access information networks such as your company's electronic mail system
- Access electronic information services such as CompuServe
- Save information you receive in a capture file
- Emulate a VT-100, ANSI, or tty terminal
- Set data transmission speed to 300, 1200, 2400, 4800, 9600, or 19200 bps
- Use the 40-column HP 95LX display as a window into an 80-column screen to communicate with systems that require a full 80-column screen
- Wrap incoming data to 40 columns when communicating with a system that does not require use of all 80 columns
- Choose among built-in configuration files, including ones to connect to CompuServe, Dow Jones News/Retrieval, or MCI Mail; or create and save your own
- Automate logon using a script file
- Transfer files using Kermit or XMODEM protocols, or as straight ASCII text

Note: Datacomm requires either the HP 82222A serial interface cable to connect directly to a remote computer, or the cable, a modem, and a modem adapter to connect by phone to the remote computer. Direct connection also may require an optional cable adapter. The filer, described below, includes additional file transfer capability.

Filer

Filer features let you:

- Create, rename, and move among directories
- View a listing of files in your directories
- View the contents of a specific file
- Rename a file
- Copy, move, or delete one file or several files at once
- Sort files by date, by extension, by size, or alphabetically by file name
- Run a program from electronic RAM disk, from a plug-in RAM card, or from ROM
- Execute MS-DOS commands available in the HP 95LX
- Transfer files between one HP 95LX and another via infrared interface
- Transfer files between an HP 95LX and an IBM-compatible PC, either through direct serial connection or via an optional modem, using the optional HP F1001A Connectivity Pack
- Simplify file management tasks, especially file transfer, using the split-screen feature; lets you see two directories at once, making it easy to copy a file from one to the other
- Print a file, set of files, or directory listing to a printer
- Play TigerFox, a chase game with 45 different mazes (available only in the U.S. and international English versions of the HP 95LX)

Setup utility features let you:

- Adjust display contrast, memory allocation, and beeper volume
- View battery level

HP F1001A Connectivity Pack HP 95LX to IBM and IBM-compatible PCs

Transfer files between your HP 95LX and your IBM-compatible PC. The pack includes necessary datacomm software, a serial interface cable, and cable adapter to make a 9- or 25-pin connection to the PC.

You can also use the 1.5-m (4.9-ft) cable to connect the HP 95LX to a serial printer or modem. (Additional cable adapter may be required.)

In addition, you receive PC versions of these HP 95LX applications: appointment book, phone book, memo editor, calculator, and filer. They work on your PC just like they work on the HP 95LX (except calculator does not include function plotting or links to Lotus 1-2-3).

The pack also includes DOS-Connect, a utility from Traveling Software, Inc. that lets your desktop PC treat the HP 95LX as a disk drive. And, you get software to translate your Central Point Software *PC Tools*, Borland *Sidekick*, or Lotus *Metro* files to HP 95LX-compatible files.

HP F1002A 128-Kbyte RAM Card for the HP 95LX Palmtop PC

HP F1003A 512-Kbyte RAM Card for the HP 95LX Palmtop PC

Add RAM. These plug-in cards act as electronic RAM disks for file storage. Use them like floppy disks. When unplugged, a card saves your information using power from its own long-lasting CR2025 battery.

HP F1005A Dictionary/Thesaurus Card for the HP 95LX Palmtop PC *Available late 1991*

Use the HP 95LX as an English electronic dictionary and thesaurus. The card includes 116,000 words and word forms from the *American Heritage Electronic Dictionary* and over 500,000 synonyms from the *Houghton Mifflin Electronic Thesaurus*. It also provides spelling correction within the HP 95LX memo editor.

HP 82222A Serial Interface Cable HP Handhelds to IBM and IBM-compatible PCs

Connect the HP 95LX to a serial device such as a printer or modem. Cable only; no software. Cable is 1.5 m (4.9 ft) with a 9-pin female connector. *Note: this cable is included in the HP F1001A Connectivity Pack.*

HP 82241A Adapter for U.S./Canada

Conserve HP 95LX battery life with this ac adapter. 110 V, 50-60 Hz. Recommended for frequent datacomm activity. (See HP 95LX Hardware Specifications section for information on adapters for other countries.)

HP 82224A Serial Cable Adapter Kit

Adapt the serial interface cable. This kit includes a printer adapter and a modem adapter. Each has a 9-pin male connector and a 25-pin male connector.



Printing and communication products from other manufacturers* for use with the HP 95LX

Kodak Diconix 150 Plus Printer*

Take advantage of go-anywhere printing capability with this battery-powered ink-jet printer. It is compatible with the Epson FX-80 and IBM Proprinter command sets. And, it prints in draft, near-letter-quality, quality, and condensed modes on cut-sheet or continuous-form plain paper. Printer speed is up to 180 characters per second.
