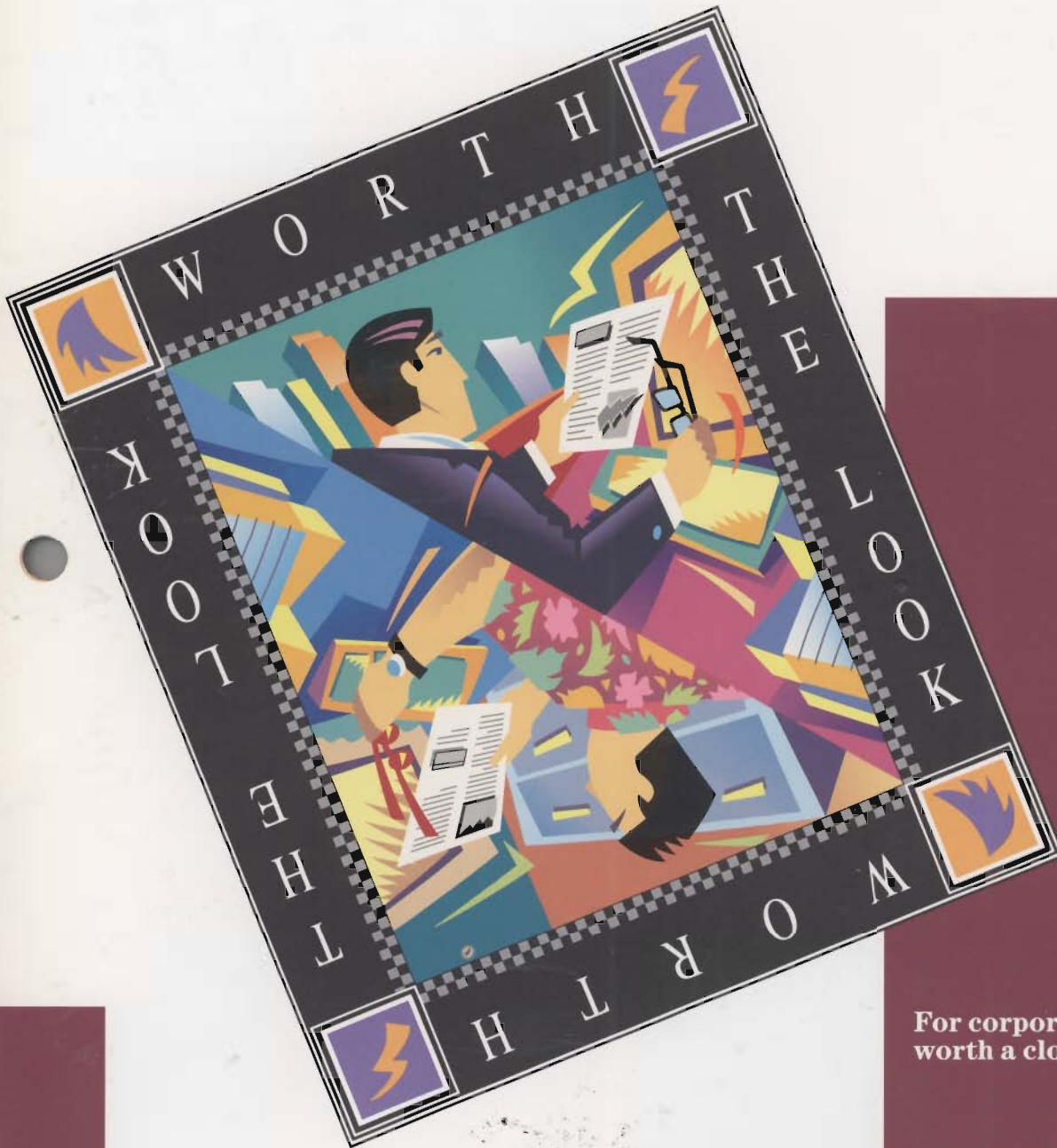

### **Inkjet: the third alternative.**

### **The HP DeskJet 500 printer: a better way.**

There's no better representative of inkjet technology than HP's new DeskJet 500 printer. The latest in a long line of HP inkjet printers, the DeskJet 500 embodies the best of the inkjet genre: stunning 300 dpi output, gorgeous graphics, proportionally spaced printing, kerned fonts, landscape printing, water-resistant ink, whisper-quiet printing, simplicity of design and operation, and guaranteed reliability.

In short, the DeskJet 500 gives you the best of alternatives one and two, without asking you to sacrifice anything. Except your old way of looking at printers.

### **Beautiful print quality at a beautiful price.**

Inkjet printers like the DeskJet 500 have evolved to 300 dots-per-inch resolution — the same as lasers — something few dot matrix printers today can duplicate. Blacks are midnight deep, text is crisp and sharp-edged, lines and charts practically reach out and grab you by the lapels. And that's just for starters.

The DeskJet 500 landscape prints spreadsheets and horizontal graphics. It does character kerning for true typeset-quality results, in both portrait and landscape modes. And it expands HP's growing font library with support for scalable fonts and proportionally-spaced printing under Microsoft® Windows 3.0.

Our new water-resistant ink freezes each page into touch-safe permanence.

But what makes you look most closely at DeskJet 500 output is the price. It's in the same neighborhood as most dot matrix printers and includes all the memory you need to do full-page 300 dpi graphics.

And therein lies the real beauty of inkjet: it pairs print quality and price in a way that no other printing alternative can.

### **Rethinking inkjet.**

For years, while most of the world was hammering out ideas on dot matrix printers, we at HP have been quietly refining our ideas about inkjet technology and turning them into products. The DeskJet 500 is the culmination of a great many advances you may not be aware of.

The ink, for instance. HP actually discovered two new chemical molecules in the process of developing the DeskJet 500 ink. It has the perfect consistency and content to meet stringent requirements for clog-free flow, paper penetration, water-resistance, optical density and fade-resistance. With the DeskJet 500, ink problems are a thing of the past.

As are jet problems. We used computer modeling and machine vision to design and test our printhead. And we use two custom integrated circuits to control it. The ink flows from the head to the paper without intermediary tubing or hardware to clog or break. The DeskJet 500 "caps" the cartridge when not in use, further preventing drying or clogging. When the cartridge runs dry — anywhere from 500 to 1,000 pages, depending on quality mode — you simply snap it out and snap in a new one. There are no messy ink refills, absolutely no muss, no fuss.

The upshot of these advances? Hewlett-Packard reliability.

### **300 dpi is just the beginning.**

Why does DeskJet 500 output look so good? Partly it's our ink and ink flow design. Partly it's our 300 dots-per-inch print density. But our software shares some of the credit.

The DeskJet 500 font design contributes subtle but significant improvements. We offer a range of handsome, laser-caliber fonts, like CG Times, all of which have been hand-tuned for peak proportion and precision. Proportionally spaced printing in both portrait and landscape modes. And fonts also feature automatic kerning—the control of inter-letter spacing—to help eyes and words come together in perfect understanding.

And the DeskJet 500 supports Intellifont® scalable typefaces under Microsoft® Windows 3.0, for flexibility in sizing headlines, footnotes, and other odd-sized text.

Courier, Univers, and CG Times outlines for both printer and screen are included in the Microsoft® Windows 3.0 driver shipped with the printer. The screen fonts give you WYSIWYG capability. Typefaces print in portrait and landscape orientations. Plus, additional scalable typefaces from the HP MasterType Library can be used.

### **Doesn't add to the office ruckus.**

What companies don't need is another noise source. Like a dot matrix jackhammer. Another reason to appreciate the DeskJet 500. With inkjet nothing hits the paper but ink.

### **When you have a need for speed.**

Inkjet technology of the '90s is so simple it involves only a few moving parts. In contrast to dot matrix printers, where each print wire must be fired, pulled back and fired again for every single dot, the DeskJet 500 simultaneously fires 50 jets of ink, 3600 times per second. So users get rapid-fire output at up to three pages per minute.

### **It won't break your heart.**

The lack of moving parts and its simple design results in another important benefit: high reliability and low downtime. The DeskJet 500 has been tirelessly tested and mercilessly stressed to wring out weaknesses and fine-tune tolerances. From the start, it's built to last. It's so strong, in fact, that we give you a three-year, limited warranty covering parts and labor. Another industry first.

### **Fits right in.**

Because of the small print cartridge and absence of bulky cooling fan and power supply, the DeskJet 500 is a true desktop companion. Measuring only 8" tall, 17" long and 15" deep, the DeskJet 500 printer sits unobtrusively on a desk corner, a bookshelf or atop a filing cabinet. We've even recessed the power cord and interface ports so you can shove it smack against the wall. That's why it's ideal for tight work spaces. It doesn't bulge. It fits.

### **Gets along famously with your favorite software.**

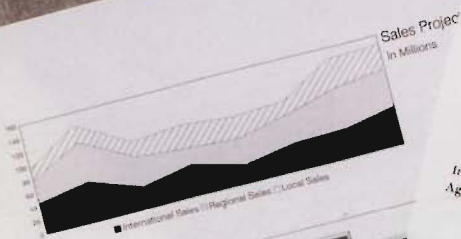

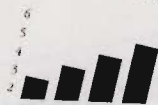

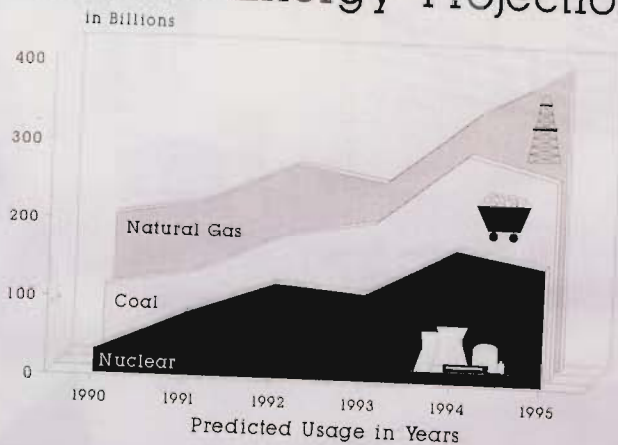
