Share files and printers with your desktop PC easily. Just plug in the included serial cable and use the built-in LapLink Remote Access. It automatically connects to your desktop PC.

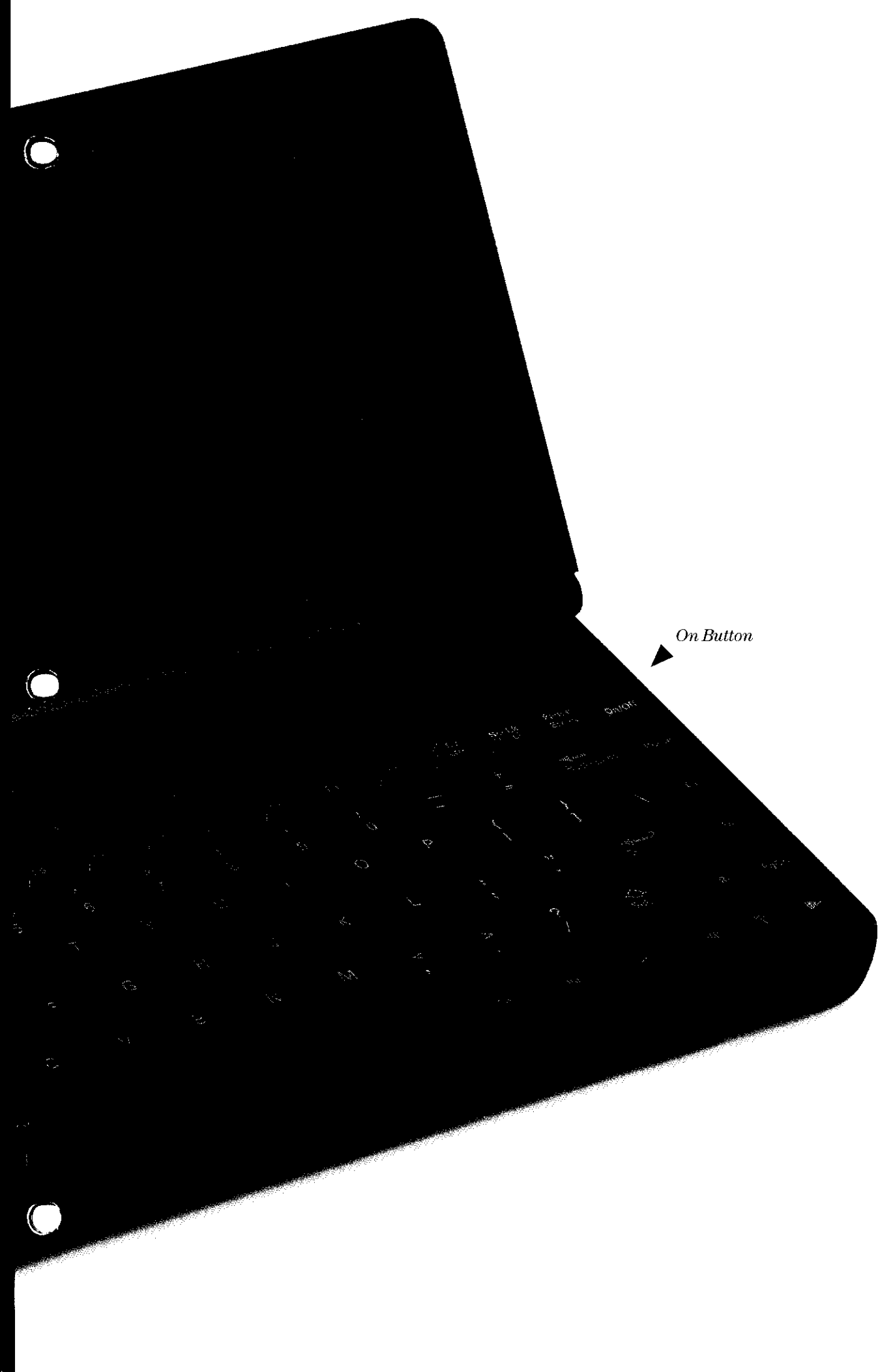
